ELIGIBILITY:

The purpose of the *Growing Together Art & Garden Event* is to share with residents what you have to offer as it relates to art and gardening. Suggested ideas: Ask the experts, plant sale, homemade jams, jellies, jewelry, and art sales, animal demonstrations, beekeeping, food and nutrition demonstrations, food storage products, handcrafted pottery, wind chimes, quilts, garden aprons, yard art, etc.

VENDOR HOURS & SET UP:

The Commission will be available at 10:00 a.m. for setup. Feel free to set up your display anywhere within the designated area. All exhibitors are expected to bring their own display units, signs, materials, tables, chairs, tents, panels, covers, etc. Electricity will NOT be available. Vendors must be set up and ready for business by 11 a.m.

PARKING:

Parking is available on the street. No parking in the City Hall or Fire Department parking lots. The Fire Department lot can be used for loading and unloading purposes only.

INDEMNITY:

To the extent permitted by law, all vendors agree to protect, indemnify, defend and hold harmless, the City of St. Paul Park and their respective volunteers against all claims, losses, damages to persons or property and costs (including attorney's fees), arising out of or connected with the event, including but not limited to, the installation, removal, maintenance, occupancy or use of park premises or part hereof, by vendor, except those claims arising out of the sole negligence or willful misconduct of the event volunteers.
